


sents sealed with my seal & dated this 20th day Jan-
-uary 1739

The condition of the above obligation is such that
if the above bound John Steel & Samuel Steel their
Heirs Esq^r or Adm^r shall & do well and truly pay or
cause to be paid unto the above named A. Edanias
Burk Esq^r his certain Attorney, Esq^r Adm^r or assigns
the last & full sum of thirty three pounds six shillings and
Eight pence sterling with lawful interest from the Twenty
fifth day of December which will be in the year one thou-
-sand seven hundred & ninety, payable in Charleston ware-
-house Tobacco notes (or other Merchantable produce at
that place) at cash price on or before the 25th Decembre
1741 without fraud or delay then this obligation to be
Void or else to remain in full force & Virtue.
