

The following deed of conveyance from Aaron Evans to Moses Evans being proven before George Salmon Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Benjamin Johnston was presented in open court & May Term 1792 and ordered to be recorded which was done this 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1792

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between Aaron Evans of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part and Moses Evans of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Aaron Evans for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Moses Evans, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and thereof exonerate and acquit the S<sup>r</sup> Moses his heirs &c. he the S<sup>r</sup> Aaron hath granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, enfeoffed, conveyed, & confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien, enfeoff, convey, and confirm unto the said Moses Evans his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract of land containing by computation sixty acres (be the same more or less) being part of a Tract of land originally granted to Jesse Mayfield and by him conveyed to William Thommach and from him made over to said Aaron Evans by a deed of conveyance bearing date the eleventh day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety situated lying and being in the County aforesaid on the North fork of Wolf's creek a branch of the Middle fork Saluda river, beginning at a pine on said Mayfield's North line and marked by Mayfield and Moore running down said line to his gum tree corner, thence to a corner persimmon tree, thence up his south line, then on a conditional line to the beginning Together with all woods, Trees & his Commons advantages Roadways, ways, waters, and appurtenances whatsoever therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also
