these presents doth bargain, sell, & deliver unto Hewell Sullivant of the County aforesaid nine County born negroes, To wit,
Sam, Tobias, Jack, Bill Phillip, Jack, Cutto, Cuff, & Pegg, for
the consideration of one hundred & one pounds Sterling the receipt
whereof we do hereby acknowledge, which Bargained Negroes
we do hereby warrant for ever defend from the just Claim of
all & every person & persons whatsoever Given under our hands
& seals this 17th Day of November 1791

Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred pounds Sterling of the State aforesaid to me in hand paid by John Hunt of the County & State aforesaid and before the Execution of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained, sold and delivered & by these presents do bargain sell & deliver unto the S. John Hunt five Negro Slaves Viz, Cate, Cap, Dyader, Hannah, & Dick to have & to hold the S. hereby bargained premises unto him the said John Hunt his Ex^{or}. Adm^r. & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the S. John Hunt his Ex^{or}. Adm^r. & assigns for ever & I the S. James Blavingame for myself my Ex^{or}. & Adm^r. the hereby Bargained premises unto the S. John Hunt his Ex^{or}. Adm^r. & assigns
