

The following Deed of Conveyance from Peter Sartor to James
Ferguson was presented in Open Court October Term 1792 & approved
by the Court of Thomas Edwards & ordered to be Recorded which was
done this 29th day of December 1792

This Indenture made this fourteenth day of January in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety Two & in
the sixteenth year of American Independence Between Peter
Sartor of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one
part & James Ferguson of the S. County & State of the other part
Whereas by a certain Grant bearing date the fifteenth day
of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & Eighty
four from under the hand of his Excellency Ben Guerard Esq. Governor
& Commander in Chief in & over the said State having the great
seal of the State thereunto affixed being for that purpose appoint-
ed did give & Grant unto Henry Rays a plantation or Tract of
land containing Two Hundred & Two acres which Tract of land
being conveyed to the above mentioned Peter Sartor situated
& lying on the waters of Brushy Creek & the the such forms & Marked
Ballings & Boundings as appear by a plat thereunto annexed which
said plat & Grant being duly recorded in the secretary's office Grant
Book A A A Page 160 reference thereunto being had may more
fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said
Peter Sartor for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars
Covenant Money of this State to him in hand paid by the said
