The following Deed of Conveyance from Micajah & Susanah  
Mayfield to Samuel M'Junkin was proven before Larkin Jar-  
rant Esq<sup>r</sup> produced in Open Court May Term 1798 and Ordered  
to be recorded which was done this 23<sup>d</sup> day of May 1798.

This Indenture made this second day of February in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred ninety three &  
in the sixteenth year of American Independance between Mi-  
cajah Mayfield of Greenville County State of South Carolina  
of the one part, & Samuel M'Junkin of the State & County  
aforesaid of the other part sheweth in & by a certain Grant  
bearing date April the seventh one thousand seven hundred  
& Eighty Eight under the hand of his Excellency Thomas  
Pinckney Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor for the time being and give & Grant  
unto Micajah Mayfield a certain plantation or Tract of  
land containing one hundred & Twenty three acres lying &  
being in the District of ninety six on both sides of Baytes  
Branch of the Middle fork of Saluda river & County of Green-  
ville and hath such shapes & Marks as appears by a plat to  
the said Grant annexed, which said plat & Grant being duly  
recorded in the Secretarys Office, reference therunto being  
had may more fully appear. Witnesseth that the said Micah-  
jah Mayfield for & in consideration of the sum of thirty Dollars  
current Money to him in hand paid by the said Samuel  
M'Junkin at or before the sealing & delivering of these
