 deration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling to him in
 hand paid at & before the sealing & delivering of these pre-
 sents the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged hath given
 Granted bargained sold aliened & confirmed & by these pre-
 sents do give grant bargain sell alien release & confirm
 unto the said William Holbrooke his heirs & assigns for ever
 certain Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred &
 fifty Acres more or less it being part of a tract of land granted
