

273 The following Deed of Conveyance from William Maston to John Byafs Blackwell was produced in Court May Term 1793 and Acknowledged in Court by the said Maston and Ordered to be Recorded, which was done this 10th day of June 1793
This Indenture made this the first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two Between William Maston of the state of South Carolina and Greenville County of the same part & John Byafs Blackwell of the other part of the County & State aforesaid witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling in hand to the said William Maston by the said John Byafs Blackwell before the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, the aforesaid William Maston hath hereby bargained sold and conveyed unto the said John Byafs Blackwell a tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less situated on the waters of Reedy River and branches of Armstrong Creek being part of two Tracts of land one containing one hundred and Ninety one acres & the other containing two hundred and Eighty six acres Originally surveyed for the said William Maston beginning at John Cars Corner on the south of Reedy River running down the original line to a stake thence a conditional line to Nicholas Barnells old line thence the said line to a red oak corner thence the said Mastons line across a Branch of Armstrong Creek to a stake thence a Conditional line to the beginning together with all and singular the water woods buildings fixtures accommodations hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever hereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said Tract of land hereby Granted and sold the same of their appurtenances unto the said John Byafs Blackwell his heirs and assigns for ever & the said William Maston for himself his heirs and assigns the said hereby bargained premises with their appurtenances unto the said John Byafs Blackwell his heirs and assigns against the claim of every person whatsoever shall and will warrant & defend by these presents In witness whereof the said William Maston hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day and date first above written
