The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Barton to Jordan Holcom being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq<sup>r</sup> was produced in Court May Term 1799 and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 12<sup>th</sup> day May 1799  
 This Indenture made the sixteenth day of December Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety one and fifth year of American Independence Between Thomas Barton of the State of South Carolina County of Greenville Capt. of the one part & Jordan Holcom of the County & State aforesaid Yeoman of the other part Whereas in the aforesaid Grant bearing date the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March 1789 under the hand of his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esquire Governor & Commander in Chief in & over the said State having the great seal of the said State thereunto affixed did give & Grant unto Thomas Barton a Tract of land containing four hundred acres situate in said County on Dochs Creek Branches and Branches of middle Sycgar River and hath such form and marks as appear by a plat to the said Grant annexed said Grant being duly recorded in the Secretaries Office reference therunto here may more fully appear Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Thomas Barton for the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Jordan Holcom before the signing and sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed by these presents with grant bargain well alien convey and confirm unto the said Jordan Holcom one hundred & fifty acres of the above survey Beginning on red oak on John Gowens Corner N 78 07-60 to a stake on Gowens line N 45 to white oak, N 93 to red oak on John Gowens line S 10 to slight wood stake on land surveyed for said Jordan Holcom thence a strait course said survey to a corner on Benjamin Ellis Corner along that line to a red oak corner thence across said survey to the Beginning red oak corner Gowens land being one hundred and fifty acres be it more or less Together with all & singular the woods under woods ways waters watercourses & hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said land belonging
