The following Deed of Conveyance from James West to Hezekiah Cochrham was produced in Open Court May Term 1793 and acknowledged by the said James West and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 17<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1793  
 This Indenture made this first Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the seventeenth year of the Independence of the United States of America Between James West of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part & Hezekiah Cochrham of the County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James West for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Hezekiah Cochrham the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed unto the said Hezekiah Cochrham his heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on the waters of the Needy fork containing one hundred & fifty acres being part of a Tract of land Originally Granted to the said James West by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> on the sixth day of November one thousand seven hundred & eighty six as by a plat annexed to the said Grant will more fully appear being Admeasured & laid out to the said Hezekiah Cochrham as follows beginning at a stone near the Road thence N 15 W to a stone near the Creek thence N 72 E down the Creek to a large White oak thence N 15 W to a stake near a pond thence S 85 E to a stone thence to Hycory thence S to White oak thence N 15 W to post oak at the upper side of the pond
