

The following Deed of Conveyance from Benjamin Smith to  
John Hinson being proven before Luther Tamant Esquire  
was presented to the Office and Recorded this 19<sup>th</sup> June 1798  
This Indenture made the tenth day of January one thousand  
seven hundred and ninety three in the seventeenth year of  
the Independance of America Between Benjamin Smith of  
Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one  
part & John Hinson of the County & State aforesaid of the other  
part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Smith for the con-  
sideration of the sum of Two hundred pounds Sterling money  
to him in hand paid by the said John Hinson the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged and him the said Benjamin Smith  
hath bargained sold released and confirmed and by these pre-  
sents doth Grant bargain Well unto John Hinson his heirs  
and assigns a Tract of Land situate lying and being in the  
County & State aforesaid containing Two hundred & five acres  
be the more or less being part of a Tract Granted by his  
Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup> to Reuben Hinger of the day of  
August 1786 Recorded in the Surintants Office Grant Book  
N. N. N. L. page 117 Beginning at a Black oak on the Bank of  
Saluda River George Goodwins Corner Running N 72 E 25 Chains  
to a post oak corner thence N 3 W 11 Chains to a Black oak thence  
S 63 E 19 Chains to a post oak thence N 72 E 39 Chains to a pine  
thence N 15 W 25 Chains & 50 links to a stake thence N 71 W 22 Ch<sup>s</sup>  
to a Maple on the Bank of Saluda thence down said River to  
the Beginning Bounded on the North by Blackbourn & Harp  
Eastwardly by John Hinson South by George Goodwin & Labarn  
Cable which will more fully appear by the plat of the same  
Together with all and singular the rights profits hereditaments  
and appurtenances whatsoever thereto or thereunto belonging or in any
