

The following Deed of Conveyance from Daniel Rodgers to Elisha Nelson being proven before James Harrison Esq. by the Oath of John Collins was Recorded this 18th day of Sept. 1793 This Indenture made the first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty nine and in the fourteenth year of American Independance between Daniel Rodgers of the state of South Carolina Edgefield County of the one part, and Elisha Nelson of the state aforesaid and Greenville County of the other part Whereas in and by an certain Grant bearing date the seventh day of May one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and in the eleventh year of American Independance, and the great seal of the State for that purpose appointed to give and Grant unto Daniel Rodgers a plantation or Tract of one hundred & fifty acres of land on the waters of a Creek called Rocky Creek in the state aforesaid & District of Ninety six now called Greenville County Recorded in the Secretary's Office for the said State in Book T.S.S. Page 226 reference therunto has more fully appear Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Daniel Rodgers for Vin consideration of fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Elisha Nelson the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged he the said Daniel Rodgers hath Granted bargained sold Released Released conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell, Release Release convey & confirm unto the said Elisha Nelson his heirs and assigns one hundred & 164 acres of Land being part of the said Tract of one hundred &
