The following Deed of Conveyance from John Nibel to Tho-  
mas Townsen being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq<sup>r</sup> by  
the oath of Peyton Nowlin & Recorded this 5<sup>th</sup> December 1799  
This Indenture made this tenth day of August in the year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between  
John Nibel of Spartanburgh County and State of South Carolina  
of the one part and Thomas Townsen of Greenville County and  
State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for a con-  
sideration of the sum of five pounds twelve shillings Sterling  
Money to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Townsen  
the Receipt whereof he does hereby acknowledge hath bargained  
sold Released and Confirmed unto the said Thomas Townsen  
his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of  
land lying being in Greenville County on the South side  
of Horse Creek containing thirty six acres be it more  
or less and bounded as followeth (to wit) beginning at a post  
oak corner in Genners Hulseys line thence S 75 E 33 50 chains  
to a stake in John Camps line thence along said Camps line N  
181 30 W to a red oak corner 18 50 thence along light Townsens line
