said William Turnbough his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> & assigns  
for ever in fee simple one hundred acres of land more or  
less being the upper part of a Tract of Land granted to Wil-  
iam Savage containing six hundred & Eighteen acres Survey-  
ed for him the thirtieth day of October one thousand seven  
hundred & Eighty Eight Situate in the District of Ninety  
six in Greenville County on a branch of Enoree River and  
branches of Childerses Beaver dam Creek of South Tyger  
bounded by lines Running North West by Hicklands land  
North East South East by Vacant Land South West South  
East by John Stitters land west by Kelley's land South East  
& South West by William Savage Land North East Kelley's land  
and Recorded Secretary's Office in Grant Book C No 5 page  
459 Reference being always thereunto had to have and to hold  
the above one hundred acres of land with their appurtenances  
and hereditaments thereunto belonging unto him the said William  
Turnbough his heirs and assigns for ever free & Clear of all  
Incumbrances and from and against the claim or claims of  
any person or persons whatsoever and he the said William  
Savage doth for himself his heirs & assigns all or either of them  
warrant and for ever defend the above one hundred acres of  
Land bargained premises with its appurtenances unto him  
the said William Turnbough his heirs & assigns for ever In  
Witness whereof the said William Savage have hereunto set  
my hand & Seal the day and year first above written
