the said John Gilbreath his heirs Ex^{ts} Adm^{rs} & assigns for
ever in fee simple one hundred & seven to one acres of land
Granted to William Savage situate in the District of Ninety
six on Enoree River bounded on lines running N. E. on John
Savage S. E. on John Turnbough N. W. N. E. & N. W. on vacant
land & that the same form and Mark mentioned & bounding was
are represented by plat and Grant the seventh day of May Anno
Domini one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven & Recorded
in Grant Book S. B. A. page 328 reference thereunto being always
had to have and to hold the above one hundred & seventy one acres
