454 The following Deed of Conveyance from John Couch to Ben-  
jamin Couch being proven before John Ford Esq<sup>r</sup> by the  
oath of James Couch was Recorded this 9<sup>th</sup> day of June 1794  
This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of September  
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety  
two between John Couch on the one part, and Benjamin Couch  
on the other both of the State of South Carolina & Greenville  
County Witnesseth that the said John Couch for and in consi-  
deration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to him in hand  
paid by the said Benjamin Couch at or before the sealing  
and delivering of these presents the Receipt payment whereof  
is hereby fully acknowledged hath given granted & sold
