Governor of said State, and bearing date January the twenty first day Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five and the ninth year of the Independance, the other one hundred & fifty acres of Land Granted by his Excellency Charles Pinckney to Daniel Kelly April the sixth one thousand seven hundred & Eighty nine and in the thirteenth year of the Independance, with all the premises thereof, and profits benefits to the only use and behoof of them the said Josiah Foster & James Roggett Foster their heirs and assigns forever and shall at all times hereafter peaceably have hold possess & enjoy the said land, and premises above mentioned two hundred and fifty acres of land without any hindrance or Interruption of them the said William Stinson & Mary Stinson or their heirs from or by them or any person or persons whatsoever, and lastly the said William Stinson and Mary Stinson doth warrant and for ever defend the same by these presents In witness whereof the said William Stinson and Mary Stinson hath hereunto set their hands & seals the day and date above written
