

being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esquire by the oath of
William Camp was Recorded this 19th day of June 1794
KNOW all men by these presents that I the within named
John Camp of the State of S^c Carolina & Greenville County for
and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & six pounds
payable to William Camp of Rutherford County N^c Carolina
and twenty four hundred weight of Merchantable Tobacco &
Twenty eight dollars to me in hand paid by Starling Camp my
son before the sealing and delivery hereof the Receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge, have assigned Transferred & set over
and by these presents do assign Transfer & set over to the said
Starling Camp of said State and County all my right, title, In-
terest, claim and demand whatsoever of in & to the within
Mentioned property viz; one Negro Man named Joseph together
with all and singular my household property & furniture, together
with all my live Stock of every kind, and all my working tools
of every kind to the said Starling Camp his heirs Exor. Adm^r. &
assigns, to have and hold the said Obligation & condition & coven-
-rants and for ever defend the within mentioned property to the
said Starling Camp from the right title or claim of any person or
persons whatsoever, and in Testimony & satisfaction hereof I do
set my hand and affix my seal the seventeenth day of Oc-
tober 1793
