480 The following deed of conveyance from Charles Lowel to  
Benjamin Walker being proven before John Thomas Esq. by  
the oath of Reuben Radmon was Recorded this 28<sup>th</sup> June 1794  
This Indenture made the first day of February in the year of  
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four Be-  
tween Charles Lowel of Greenville County and State of  
South Carolina of the one part, and Benjamin Walker of the  
County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the  
said Charles Lowel for and in consideration of the sum of  
fifty pounds lawfull Sterling Money of the said State to him  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Benjamin Walker at &  
before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold  
aliened released conveyed and confirmed, and by these  
presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey and  
confirm unto the said Benf. Walker all that tract or parcel of  
land Joining the lands of byrbrain Farnar and the said Charles  
Lowel and being part of the land of the said Charles Lowel on  
which he now lives and which was granted to Michael Johnston  
on the first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred and eighty seven for one hundred Fifty  
acres lying on Brushy Creek on the south side of Enoree River
