oath of John Wood was Recorded this 24th day of June 1794
This Indenture made fourth day of September one thousand
seven hundred and ninety three Between Charles Dougherty
of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the
one part and Henry Wood of the State and County aforesaid
of the other part Witnesses that for and in considera-
tion of the sum of five pounds to him in hand paid at and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained
sold and conveyed, and by these presents do hereby grant
bargain sell and convey unto the said Henry Wood his heirs
and assigns one hundred and sixteen acres of land being
part of a Tract granted to Mary White by his Excellency Willi-
am Moultrie Esq. the third day of October one thousand seven
hundred and eighty five and in the tenth year of American Inde-
pendance lying in Greenville County aforesaid on Armstrongs
Creek to have and to hold the aforesaid bargained premises
with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging without any man-
ner Incumbrance whatsoever unto the said Henry Wood his
heirs and assigns for ever, and the said Charles Dougherty for him-
self his heirs Executors and Assigns the aforesaid bargained pre-
