This Indenture made the day of and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred ninety three in the seventeenth year of American Independence between John Waldrop Jun^r of the State of South Carolina & Greenville County of the one part & Frederick Farmer of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the S^r. John Waldrop do in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the S^r. Frederick Farmer at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the S^r. John Waldrop doth hereby acknowledge & from every part & parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the S^r. Frederick Farmer his heirs & assigns & for divers other good causes & considerations hereunto moving have granted & assigned sold Enfeoffed & confirmed unto him the S^r. Frederick Farmer his heirs & assigns for ever a parcel or part of a tract of land lying & being in Greenville County on a branch of the Golden Plover Originally granted to the S^r. John Waldrop Jun^r on the fourth day of February 1790 as by a plat therunto annexed will fully appear for one hundred & seventy acres of land it beginning on a pine on the NW line agreed on & from thence running alone agreed on through the middle of S^r. tract of land it being for the North East half of S^r. tract of land adjoining to Barry Roark containing by estimation Eighty five acres more or less together with all singular the houses ways waters trees & other appurtenances whatsoever to the S^r. parcel or part of the S^r. tract of land so described above belonging or in any wise appurtening & the Reverious Remainders rents Issues & profits thereof and every part & parcel thereof & all the estate right title Interest claim & demand whatsoever both in Law & Equity of the S^r. John Waldrop Jun^r of in & to the S^r. premises & of in & to every part & parcel thereof to have & to hold the parcel or tract of land as above mentioned & all & singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the S^r. Frederick Farmer his heirs & assigns unto the only proper use & behoof of him the S^r. Frederick Farmer his heirs & assigns for ever & lastly the S^r. John Waldrop for himself & for his heirs the S^r. tract of land its appurtenances unto the S^r. Frederick Farmer him his heirs & assigns against all persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & for ever defend In Witness whereof the S^r.
