 being proved before John Alexander Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of William  
 Stone was presented and Recorded this 14th day of January 1795  
 This Indenture made this twenty first day of April in the year of  
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty four between William  
 Stone of the State of South Carolina & Greenville County of the one part &  
 John Ashmore of the State & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth  
 that the s<sup>r</sup>. William Stone for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred  
 & fifty pounds lawful sterling money to him in hand well & truly paid at &  
 before the sealing & delivering of these presents by the s<sup>r</sup>. John Ashmore the  
 receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged has given granted bargained  
 sold aliened released & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant  
 bargain sell alien release & confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup>. John Ashmore him his  
 heirs & assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in  
 the County of Greenville & on Rocky Creek & Reedy River Viz, all the land  
 vested in the s<sup>r</sup>. William Stone by virtue of a Deed of conveyance made to  
 the s<sup>r</sup>. William Stone by Neamon Hudson bearing date on the twelfth day  
 of January one thousand seven hundred & thirty three which s<sup>r</sup>. land was  
 made to the s<sup>r</sup>. Hudson by James Harrison bearing date on the tenth day of  
 September one thousand seven hundred & thirty two reference thereto  
 will more fully appear, also all the land vested in the s<sup>r</sup>. William Stone
