


The following Bill of Sale from Hugh Crumbliss to Warick Bristow being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq. by the oath of John Easter was presented & Recorded this 13<sup>th</sup> February 1795  
 State of S. Carolina Know all men by these presents that  
 that Hugh Crumbliss of Greenville County School Master  
 of the state aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of twenty  
 pounds Sterling Money to me in hand paid by Warick Bristow  
 a planter of Greenville County at & before the sealing and  
 delivering of these presents wherewith I confess myself to be  
 fully satisfied & paid in hand bargained & sold & by these pre-  
 sents do fully bargain & sell unto the said Warick Bristow  
 my housal goods one certain piece of land called Beul's land  
 containing 300 acres, one Cow & one Horse the goods consisting  
 of two beds & Bedchads & Bed furniture six chairs 2 stools & one  
 Dutch Oven 2 new tin Basons six plates one Dish one no horn  
 Cow & Calf one two year old Heifer 5 Stools & one Sow big with  
 pigs one ax 2 hoes one plow hoe & Mattock one flax wheel  
 one Cotton Wheel 100 lb. Cotton in Seed to have & to hold each  
 and every Article herein above mentioned to the said Warick  
 Bristow his Executors Administrators & assigns to his & to his  
 their own proper use and behoof for ever & I Hugh Crum-  
 bliss my heirs Exors Admrs & every of us do confess this our  
 Bill of Sale against all manner of persons whatsoever  
 will warrant & for ever defend unto the said Warick Bristow  
 his heirs & assigns by these presents In witness hereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand & seal this first day of May in the  
 year of our Lord 1794

 This Indenture made this ninth day of April in the year of  
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two Between  
 Samuel Tarrant of the County of Greenville & State of South Caro-  
 lina of the one part & James Tarrant of the said County and  
 State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Tar-  
 rant for & in consideration of the sum of forty pounds lawfull  
 Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said James Tarrant  
 before the sealing of these presents the receipt wherof is hereby
