This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of January Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety three of the Independence of the United States the eighteenth Between Unity Moore of the state of South Carolina County of Greenville of the one part & John McCormick of the ~~state~~ County afores^d of the other part witnesseth for her consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling lawful Money of S^t State in hand paid by John McCormick hath bargained and sold by these presents doth bargain sell & make over unto said John McCormick a certain plantation or tract of land lying in Greenville County on Rockey Creek of Broad River which John McCormick now lies on & hath such boundaries whereas it begining on a stake on certain line on Len^s Hudsons land thence running S^E to the corner post oak thence S^E to stake corner near some saplin thence S^E to post oak saplin thence N^E to red oak corner thence to stake on certain line on Len^s Hudsons land thence along certain to the begining it being apart of a tract of land containing two hundred & fourteen acres granted unto Francis Fletcher from under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r bearing date the fourth day of Dec^r one thousand seven hundred & eighty six Recorded in Book Z Z Z page 231 he hath granted bargained & sold by these presents doth bargain sell & convey unto the said John McCormick a tract of land containing one hundred & seven acres more or less together with the woods waters hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining and reversion & reversion remainder & remainders unto Irenus & profits thereof to have & to hold the grantees premises of the above mentioned tract of land unto the said John McCormick his heirs Esq^r or assigns for ever ty. v.
