The following Deed of Conveyance from Stephen Cantrell to Israel Miller being sworn before John Thomas Esq^r. by the oath of John Miller was presented & recorded this 7th day of April 1795

This Indenture made this seventh day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three & in the eighteenth year of American Independence Between Stephen Cantrell of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part & Israel Miller of the County & State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the said Stephen Cantrell for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Israel Miller at & before the sealing & delivering of these pres- ents, the receipt whereof the said Stephen Cantrell doth hereby acknowledge, he the said Stephen Cantrell hath granted bargained & sold aliened & confirmed by these presents with grant & bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said Israel Miller his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less situated in Greenville County on both sides of Enoree river begining on a post oak on Edward Ballingers Corner, from thence to the head of a branch on the said Ballingers line to a stake corner from thence running a straight course across the little Thorel to a red oak corner on the south side Enoree river, from thence down the river to a holly corner on Hitchums line from thence along the said Hitchums line to a stake corner, from thence to the begining it being part of a tract of land containing five hundred & eighty seven acres Granted the said Edward Ballinger under the hand of his attorney William Moretree Esq^r. bearing date the seventh of November one thousand seven hundred & eighty five, Recorded in the Secretarys Office Grant Book E E E page 534 reference thereto being had may more fully appear together with all trees woods under woods tithes commons common of pasture profits commodities hereditaments & pur- tenances whatsoever to the said Mesuage or Tenement & premises
