

Between Samuel Tarrant of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the first part & Thomas Camp of the same State and County aforesaid of the second part Witnesseth that for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds Sterling Money paid by the said Thomas Camp the receipt whereof the said Samuel Tarrant doth hereby acknowledge he the said Samuel Tarrant hath bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas Camp his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of land containing one hundred and forty nine acres situate in the County of Greenville on Horse Creek and the district of Washington Beginning at a Red oak on said Thomas Camps land and Running thence S. E. 29-27 ch<sup>o</sup>. 50 to a pine on the old Indian boundary line thence N. W. 44-44 ch<sup>o</sup>. 72 to a stake on Harris Mullins land from thence N. W. 31-44 ch<sup>o</sup>. 50 to a stake on Thomas Camps land from thence to the Beginning being a Tract of land granted to the said Samuel Tarrant by his Excellency and bearing date the 2<sup>nd</sup> day April 1789 and Recorded in Secretaries Office in grant Book Vol. X. XIV page 360 reference hereunto had may more fully appear together with all Trees woods under woods timber common of pasture advantages hereditaments ways waters water courses and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appurtenanting, and also Reversion and Reversions Remainders rents and Services of the same and of every part and parcel thereof and all the Interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Samuel Tarrant either in Law or equity unto the same to have and to hold the said tract of one hundred and forty nine acres of land be the same more or less and all and singular the premises above mentioned with every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Camp his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Samuel Tarrant for him and his heirs the said tract of one hundred and forty nine acres of land with every the premises thereunto belonging against him the said Samuel Tarrant his heirs Executors and Adm<sup>r</sup>. and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever unto Thomas Camps heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Samuel Tarrant hath hereunto set his hand Seal the day and date first above written
