 the Mill dam and running up the said branch to widow Sowell's line
 thence along that line to the North West fork of the s^r Mill Creek
 thence down that Creek to the beginning, the same containing fifty
 acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the
 houses buildings gardens orchards trees woods under woods tithes
 commons commons of pasture profits commodities Advantages
 hereditaments ways waters water courses and appurtenances what-
 soever to the same belonging or any ways appertaining and also
