The following deed of conveyance from James Hide to David Weeks being
proven before John Blasingame by the oath of Patrick Cofferty was
presented and Recorded this 17th day of June AD 1795

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of April in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between James
Hide of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the part of David
Weeks of the said State and County of the other part witnesseth that the s:^r
James Hide for and in consideration of the sum of twenty four pounds
sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the s:^r David
Weeks at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the
receipt hereof the said James Hide doth hereby acknowledge and
thence and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit
and discharge the said David Weeks his heirs and assigns and for
divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving
have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed
unto the said David Weeks his heirs and assigns for ever all that par-
cel or Tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on both
sides of the Road of the branch the waters of reedy river containing fifty
acres more or less begining at a post oak x on Cofferty's line from thence
to a pine x from thence to a post oak on Jacob Black x along the s:^r line
to a stake x from thence to Sweets line & along Sweets line to a white oak
on the branch x up the branch the branch being the line to a post oak x
from thence to the begining corner it being apart of a tract of land contain-
ing two hundred acres Originally granted unto John Cofferty & signed by
his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the sixt day of October one thousand
seven hundred and eighty eight ac by a plat annexed to the same grant
will more fully appear together with all and singular the houses and
buildings walls paths passages trees fences easements & appurtenan-
ces whatsoever to the said tract of land so described as above belonging
