 Ross being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq. by the oath of Will
 am Wilburn was presented & recorded this 14th Day of Aug. 1795
 This Indenture made this nineteenth Day of May one thous
 and seven hundred & ninety five for the nineteenth year of the inde
 pendence of the united States of America between William Hal
 brook of the state of South Carolina & County of Greenville of
 the one part & James Ross of the state aforesaid of the other
 part Witnesseth that the s. William Halbrook for & in consideration
 of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand well
 & truly paid at & before the sealing & delivering of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & from the s. William
 Halbrook hath given granted bargained sold, enjoyed released & confi
 rmed unto the s. James Ross his heirs & assigns one certain tract
 or parcel of Land situate & in Ninety six District on the north
 side of Saluda river & on the s. side containing ^{three hundred Acres} more or less gra
 nted to John Martin by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq
 Granted & dated the third Day of September one thousand seven hun
 dred & eighty seven & from the s. Martin conveyed to the s.
 William Halbrook by a deed bearing date the eighteenth
 Day of November one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight
 containing three hundred Acres of Land more or less lying & being
 as afores. beginning at a post on the line 3 + thence N 3 E
 15 to a black oak 3 + thence S 62 E 42 to a stake 3 + thence running
 with the Survey Morise line to Interest the widow Neasons
