 William Armstrong of the State of S. Carolina & Greenville County
 of the one part & Nehemiah Payne of the S. State & County afores.
 of the other part witnesseth that the S. William Armstrong for
 the Consideration of twenty pounds Sterling money to him in hand pd.
 by the S. Nehemiah Payne the receipt whereof is hereby Ackno-
 wledged have granted & sold unto the S. Nehemiah Payne a
 certain tract of Land situate in Greenville County on the
 waters of the Golden Grove branch of Saludy River containing six
 by Acres more or less it being part of a tract of Land originally
 granted to the S. William Armstrong the 14th day of
