

The following Deed of Conveyance from Joseph Reed to Drury Morris being sworn before John Alexander Esq. by the oath of Michael Henderson was printed & recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of Aug 1793 This Indenture made the fiftenth Day of Aprile one thousand seven hundred & ninety three, between Joseph Reed of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part, & Drury Morris of the County & State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the S<sup>r</sup>. Reed for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & ninety Dollars current money to him in hand Paid by the S<sup>r</sup>. Morris the receipt whereof he Doth hereby acknowledge & thereof Exonerate the S<sup>r</sup>. Morris his heirs &c, he the S<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Reed, hath granted, bargained, sold, Alien'd, enfeoff'd, released, convey'd, & confirmed, & by these presents doth Grant, bargain, Sell, Alien, Enfeoff, Release, Convey & confirm unto the S<sup>r</sup>. Drury Morris, his heirs & assigns forever, A Tract of Land containing three hundred & eighty six Acres, more or less, (being part of an old tract of three hundred Acres originally granted to Robt. Paine bearing Date August the first 1763 also a Tract granted to S<sup>r</sup>. Reed, bearing Date May the fifth 1791 Reference to these Deeds being had will more fully appear) situate in the County aforesaid on both sides of Mountain Creek; beginning at a post Oak Corn 3+ thence to a steep hollow the first below Williams's Spring to a Stake on the Creek 3+ thence Down ~~the~~ <sup>to</sup> Creek, the place where an old bridge formerly stood thence up a lane to John Brunk's line thence along S. line S W 51. 24. 75 to a Stake 3+ thence S E 56, 27 1/2 to a Stake 3+ thence N. E. 34, 12, 15 0 1/2 to a hickery 3+ thence on S<sup>r</sup>. Reed's new Survey S. E, 80, 32 26 1/2 to a Stake corner on S<sup>r</sup>. Morris's line thence N E 10 53. 50 1/2 to a Stake on Reed's ~~old~~ <sup>new</sup> line thence on S<sup>r</sup>. Reed's line to the beginning together with all woods, trees, tithes, Commons, <sup>advantages</sup> ways, waters, & appertinances, whatsoever, thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining And also the surrenders & surrenders, Remainders & Remainders, Rents & services of S<sup>r</sup>. premises, & of every part thereof & all the estate, right, title, Interest or demand, whatsoever, of him that the Joseph Reed, of, in, & to the same, To have & to hold the S<sup>r</sup>. Tract of Land & premises above mentioned, & every part thereof with the appertinances, unto the S<sup>r</sup>. Drury Morris, his heirs & assigns forever & the S<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Reed, for himself & his heirs, the S<sup>r</sup>. Tract of Land & every the premises thereto belonging, against him the S<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Reed, his heirs, Exors. Adors. & all other persons unto the S<sup>r</sup>. Drury Morris his heirs & assigns, shall & lawfully warrant & forever defend by this present to him whosoever who the S<sup>r</sup>. Joseph Reed hath set his hand & affixed his seal, the Day & Date above written
