

The following Deed of Conveyance from Joseph Reed to Drury Morris being given before John Alexander Esq^r by the oath
 of Michael Henderson was presented & recorded this 15th Day of Aug^t
 1795 This Indemnity made the fifteenth day of April
 one thousand seven hundred & ninety three, between Joseph Reed of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part, & Drury Morris of the County & State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth, that the s^r.
 Reed for & in Consideration of the sum of one hundred & Ninety Pounds
 current Money to him in hand Paid by the s^r. Morris the receipt
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof Exonerate the s^r. Morris
 & his heirs &c, to the s^r. Joseph Reed, hath granted, bargained, sold,
 aliened, enfeoffed, released, conveyed, & confirmed, & by these presents
 doth Grant, bargain, sell, alien, Enfeoff, release, Convey & Confirm
 unto the s^r. Drury Morris, his heirs & assigns forever, A tract of Land
 containing three hundred & Eighty Six Acres, more or less, (being part
 of an old tract of three hundred acres originally granted to Robt.
 Prince bearing Date August the first 1765 also a Tract granted
 to s^r. Reed, bearing Date May the fiftieth 1791 reference to those lands
 being had will more fully appear) situate in the County aforesaid
 on both sides of Mountain Creek; beginning at a post
 Oak corner 3 + thence to a step hollow the first below William's
 Spring to a Stake on the Creek 3 + thence down the Creek to the place
 where an old bridge formerly stood thence up by lane to John Br.
 work's line thence along S. line S 45° 51' 24.75 to a Stake 3 +
 thence S E 56.27 L. to a Stake 3 + thence N. E. 34.12, 85.04
 to a hickory 3 + thence on S. Reed's new Survey S. E. 80, 32.
 26 L. to a Stake corner on s^r. Morris's line thence N E 10.
 53.50 L. to a Stake on Reed's old ~~west~~ line thence on S.
 line to the beginning together with all wood, trees, timber, commo.
 ns, ways, water, & appurtenances, whatsoever, thereto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining And also the herbage & inclosure, remain
 der & remainder, rents & issues of s^r. promises, & of every part thereof
 & all the estate, right, title, Interest or demand, whatsoever, of him
 the s^r. Joseph Reed, of, in, & to the same, To have & to hold
 the s^r. Tract of Land & premises above mentioned, & every part thereof
 with the appurtenances, unto the s^r. Drury Morris, his heirs &
 signs forever & the s^r. Joseph Reed, for himself & his heirs, the said
 Tract of Land & every the premises thereto belonging, against
 him the s^r. Joseph Reed, his heirs, Exec^t & donee & all other
 persons unto the s^r. Drury Morris his heirs & signs, shall & will
 warrant & forever defend by these presents to Drury Morris during the s^r.
 Joseph Reed's life, & his heirs & assigns his seat, the day & date above
 written & subject to the payment of the sum of £ 1000 per annum
 till paid & no more after full payment.
