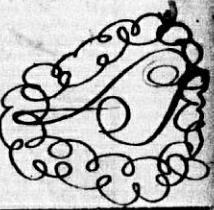

The following Deed of Conveyance from Absalom Carnoy to George Sanders being shown before Robert M. Jee Esq^r. by the oath of William Russell Sen^r. was presented & recorded this 25th Day of August A.D. 1793

This Indenture made the fourteenth Day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three and in the seventeenth year of the independance of the united States of America between Absalom Carnoy of the State of South Carolina in Greenville County of the one part & George Sanders of the State & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the S^r. Absalom Carnoy for an in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand well & truly paid by the S^r. George Sanders at or before the sealing & delivering of the presents the receipt whereof the S^r. Absalom Carnoy doth hereby Acknowledge he the S^r. Absalom Carnoy hath granted bargained & sold Alien'd & confirm'd & by these presents doth Grant bargain & sell Alien and confirm unto the S^r. George Sanders his heirs & assigns forever a certain Tract of Land by computation containing one hundred Acres part of a Tract of two hundred & seventy Acres Granted to George Russell by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq^r. Situated in the District of Ninety Six on both sides of Kings branch of Enore River &c. Tract doth join William Russells ^{land} beginning on a black oak at a corner, the South line running with a marked line to the mouth of a small branch thence up the branch to the line bearing date third Day of May on the year one thousand seven hundred & ninety recorded in the secretaries office Grant Book B, N^o. Page 279 ^{being} reference therunto had may more fully appear Together with all trees woods underwoods & other common or common water & water courses whatsoever to the S^r. Tract belonging or in any wise appertaining also the enclosures & enclosures remain'd & remain'ders tents & services of the S^r. premises & of every part thereof & also all the rights titles interest Claim or Demand of him the S^r. Absalom Carnoy or his heirs the S^r. Tract of Land containing one hundred Acres more or less and Enore part thereof to have & to hold all things
