

The following Deed of Conveyance from Charles Pope to Elizabeth Wedge being proven before Hilgore Esq by the oath of John Ashmore was presented & recorded this 24 Day of August 1875

This Indenture made this twenty fifth Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventy five & in the nineteenth year of the Independence of America between Charles Pope of the State of S. Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part & Elizabeth Wedge of the S. State & C. of the other part witnesseth that the S. Charles Pope for & in Consideration of the sum of fifty Pounds to him in hand paid by the S. Elizabeth Wedge at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the S. Charles Pope both hereby acknowledges & of from every part & parcel thereof do Equit & discharge the S. Elizabeth Wedge her heirs & assigns have Granted Bargained sold & confirmed & by these presents do we grant bargain sell alien enjoin & confirm unto her the S. Elizabeth Wedge her heirs & assigns forever all that plantation or tract of one hundred acres of Land be the same more or less originally granted to James Seaborn & sign'd by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney the fifth Day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine Situate in Greenville County on both Sides of Spring Creek bounded on the N. E. for the N. E. Sides on Thomas Longs Land & on the N. W. on vacant Land being laid out unto the S. Elizabeth Wedge as follows beginning on black oak Corner N 30 E 44 6. to a Stake Corner from thence running N 50 E 2 0 to a red oak from thence running N 40 W 40 to a pine Corner & from thence to the beginning including one hundred acres of Land be it more or less together with all & singular the houses out houses ways water paths passages trees fences enclosures & improvements & appurtenances whatsoever to the S. Tract of Land so described as above belonging or in any wise appertaining & the Division & divisions Remainder & Remainders Rents issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof & all the estate right title int. Claim & Demand whatsoever both in Law & equity ~~of him the S. Charles Pope~~ of him the S. Charles Pope of in & to the same premises & in & to every part & parcel thereof to have & to the S.
