



Excellency Charles Pinkney Esq: then Governor and commander in chief of the state

 all houses woods waters and water courses profits & Emoluments thereunto belonging or
 any ways appertaining to have and to hold the said bargained and sold premises with the
 appertinances unto the said Joseph Hawke his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple &
 that he is at the time of conveying of the said lands possessed of a good and lawful right &
 title in fee simple and the said Samuel Duncan and Sarah his wife doth here by warrant &
 forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid lands unto the said Joseph Hawke his
 heirs & assigns forever as aforesaid against the claim or claims of every other person
 or persons that may at any time hereafter set up any claim or claims or title
 to the same in witness hereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals the year and

The following Bill of Sale from Charles Sullivant to Hewlet Sullivant
 being proven before Thomas Camp Esq: by the oath of Wm
 Milbank was presented and recorded this 26th day of Jan^y 1796

This Indenture made the first Day of October 1795 Between Charles
 Sullivant of the County of Grenville and state of South Carolina of the one part
 and Hewlet Sullivant of the County & state aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
 the said Charles Sullivant for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pound
 sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Hewlet Sullivant the
 Recd. whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold aliened and confirmed
 and by these presents doth bargain sell alien confirm unto the said Hewlet Sullivant
 one negro fellow named Tom and one negro fellow named Dub. Some negro wench named
 Dol to have and to hold the above mentioned negroes to the said Hewlet Sullivant
 his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said Hewlet Sullivant &
 his assigns and the said Charles Sullivant doth hereby warrant and forever defend the
 above sold negroes unto the said Hewlet Sullivant his heirs assigns and the said
 Charles Sullivant doth put the above sold negroes in the full possession of the said
 Hewlet Sullivant by the Delivery of said negroes in witness whereof the S: Charles
 Sullivant hath hereunto set his hand and seal the Day and year first
