Cawnder the receipt & payment whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given & grant bargained for & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain for & sell unto the above Thos. Cawender his heirs Exec. admt & assigns forever one certain tract of land situate in the aforesaid County of Greenville being a part of a tract of land on the north side of the South fork of Saluda river formerly the property of W^m Clayton & is bounded by lands of Samuel Early Joseph Maxwell Matthew Hallins Thomas White & William White containing 100 acres less or more together with all the appurtenances & privileges therunto belonging or in any ways appertaining with the reservation unto witness & friends to him & his heirs & admt. & assign to have & to hold occupy & enjoy until time shall be no more & further agree to warrant & defend the aforesaid title of the S^r tract of one hundred acres of land more or less as above described with the appurtenances of the same unto the S^r Thos. Cawender his heirs Exec. admt. & assigns against the claims or claims of himself his heirs Exec. admt & assigns of all & every other person what so ever in witness whereof the S^r Zilpha Burch hereunto set her hand & affixed her seal the day & date first above written signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us —
