



Hilgou was presented and Recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> day of April AD 1796

State of South Carolina Greenville County This Indenture made  
this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and  
ninety three and the 18<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the United States between  
Nicholas White of the one part, & Joseph Woolbanks of the other part & both of the  
State and county aforesaid witnesseth that for and in consideration of five  
pounds lawful Money in hand paid by Joseph Woolbanks to Nicholas White, hath  
bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell & confirm unto the s:  
Joseph Woolbanks all that tract or parcel of land containing three hundred & fifty three  
acres be the same more or less, having such shape form and marks bennings &  
boundings as the above plat represents it being a part of a tract of seven hun-  
dred and three acres of Land granted to the s: Nicholas White the seventh day January  
1798 and the said Nicholas White doth covenant & agree to & with said Joseph  
Woolbanks that he will for ever warrant and defend the above described Land  
with all its appurtenances or profits thereunto or in any wise appertaining there-  
unto from himself his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns & no further  
unto the s: Joseph Woolbanks he his heirs or assigns In witness whereof the s: Nicholas  
White hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & date first above written
