

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of Oct: in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four & in the nineteenth year of the American Independence between James Copeland of the State of Carolina Greenville County of the one part & Benj: West of the State of N.C. Carolina Mecklenburg County of the other part witnesseth that whereas in & by a certain Grant bearing date of twenty first day of Jan: in the year AD one thousand seven hundred & eighty four under the hand of his Excellency Benj: Gerard Esq: Governor Commander in chief in & over the State having the great seal of the State thereunto affixed did give and grant unto Arch: Dill a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation four hundred acres situate lying & being in the S. of State aforesaid on a Creek of S. Tygar River adjoining land laid out to Henry Prince which plat of grant being duly recorded in Secretaries Office of S. State reference thereto had will more fully appear & the S. Arch: Dill conveyed by deed two hundred acres of the aforesd tract of land unto the aforesd James Copeland it being the upper end of the said tract of land on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1793 which deed of conveyance being duly recorded in the Clerks Office of S. County reference thereto being had will more fully appear now this Indenture witnesseth that the S. James Copeland for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Benjamin West at or before the signing sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged have bargained & sold aliened conveyed and confirmed by these presents both grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the S. Benj: West his heirs & executors one hundred & ninety acres of land by S. James more or less beginning on a conditional corner made between Maj: Th: Gowen & the S. James Copeland it being a Red oak tree running thence N. 60 E 45 ch. along the old line to a Red oak corner thence S. 30 E to conditional corner agreed on between the S. James Copeland and Arch: Adcomb thence along S. agreed line to a hickory corner on the Creek thence up the Creek to the old line thence along the old line to a post oak corner thence S. 60 W 45 ch. to an agreed Chestnut tree between the S. Th: Gowen & James Copeland thence to the beginning agreed corner free including the Improvement the S. James Copeland now lies on containing by estimation one hundred & ninety acres the same more or less together with all and singular the gardens, ways wells waters water courses woods under woods easements profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging to have & hold the S. granted premises of one hundred & ninety acres of Land be the same more or less unto the only proper use & behoof of him the S. Benj: West his heirs & executors & assigns now delivered into his actual possession the S. Benj: West & that the S. James Copeland his heirs executors & assigns doth covenant & agree to & with the S. Benj: West his heirs executors & assigns that they shall at all times hereafter peaceably & quietly occupy possess & enjoy the S. Granted premises of one hundred & ninety acres of Land be the same more or less from all former sales mortgages judgments executions & all Incumbrance whatsoever by, to, or from the S. James Copeland his heirs executors & assigns shall & will warrant & for ever defend the S. tract of one hundred & ninety acres of Land be the same more or less unto the S. Benj: West his heirs executors & assigns from all and every other person or persons laying claim thereto to testify in witness whereof the S. James Copeland hath hereunto set my hand & signed my seal the day & year first above written
