244 The following deed of Conveyance from George Benson to John
 West being proven before Robert Mafee Esq^r by the oath of Robert
 Mason was presented & Recorded this 21st day of April A.D. 1796
 This Indenture made the thirteenth day of December in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three between George Benson
 of the State of South Carolina County of Greenville of the one part & John
 West of the aforesaid County State of the other part witnesseth that the
 said George Benson for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds
 Sterling Money to him in hand well & truly paid by the said John West at
 and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
 s^rd George Benson doth hereby acknowledge, he the s^rd George Benson hath
 granted bargained & sold aliened conveyed & confirmed, by these presents doth
 grant bargain & sell alien convey & confirm unto the said John West his
 heirs & assigns for ever & certain tract of Land lying & being in the County of
 Greenville on Enore River containing one hundred & thirteen acres Originally
 granted to the said George Benson by his Excellency William Moultrie Grant
 bearing date the sixth day of March one thousand seven hundred & eighty six
 and recorded in Grant Book A.B.B.B page 195 reference being thereto had
 may more fully appear together with all trees woods & works to this commons
 common water & water courses whatsoever to the said tract belonging or in any
