 Edwards was presented and recorded this 6<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1796  
 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that  
 Solomon Langston of Laurens County in the State aforesaid for & in  
 consideration of the sum of ten pounds to me in hand paid by James  
 Langston son of Seoniah Langston of Greenville in the said State have  
 granted bargained and sold & released, and by these presents do grant  
 bargain sell and release unto the said James Langston that Tract of land  
 whereon his mother now lives including one hundred acres with the houses  
 and Improvements to be laid out as is most justly &c. it being part of a  
 Survey of six hundred forty acres conveyed from James Langston to  
 Solomon Langston as the records of Greenville Court will make appear  
 also there is nothing in this conveyance to deprive his Mother Mary  
 Langston of the advantages or possession of the said land during her na-  
 tural life Together with all and singular the rights members here-  
 detaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
 Incident or appurtenant to have and to hold all and singular the pre-  
 mises before mentioned unto the said James Langston his heirs and  
 assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c. to warrant  
 and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 James Langston his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs &c. and against  
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
