and assigns for ever and the said John Childress for himself his
heirs Executors & Administrators the said tract of one hundred acres
of land tenement and premises and every part & parcel thereof

trators for ever, shall and will warrant and for ever defend by

from all and every other person or persons whatsoever laying any lawful
