plates two pots stone oven & one Skillet, two Razors, two Bedsteads  
thirty head of Hogs Market with a brace & a hole & a half brace in  
left a judgment against Mr. Mullans for sixteen <sup>dollars</sup> to have and to  
hold the said mentioned property unto the above mentioned  
Simpson & Wm. Ross Mss. their Executors Administrators & assigns
