

 James Stevenson the Original Grantee and from him the s^d James
 Stevenson sold and convey'd unto my s^d Patrick Daly viz half of the
 above tract or parcel of land which is one hundred & thirty acres of land
 by the same more or less of which these presents I have delivered here to
 my said son James Daly an Inventory signed with my own hand and
 bearing date to have and to hold all the said one hundred & thirty acres
 of land by the same more or less and all the premises & appurtenan-
 ces appertaining thereto unto my said son James Daly his heirs Ex-
 adm^s & assigns from henceforth as his & their property & enjoyment
 Interest right Title claim & demand absolutely without any manner of
 Condition, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
 seal this Twentieth day of January Anno Domini one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety six

The following Deed of Conveyance from William Whaley to Eli
 Turnbough being proven before Reuben Barreto Esq^r by the oath
 of William D Thomas was presented & recorded this 12th August 1796
 This Indenture was made the thirtieth day of December one thousand
 seven hundred ninety six & in the twentieth year of American Independen-
 ce between William Whaley of the State of South Carolina & County of
 Greenville of the one part & Eli Turnbough of the State & County afores^d
 planter of the other part whereas that in & by a certain Grant bearing date
 the second day of September Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred &
 ninety three under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Go-
 v^rnor of s^d State having the great seal of the State therunto affixed did
 give and grant unto the said William Whaley a certain tract of land con-
 taining two hundred & fifty five acres situated in ninety six District on
 Beaver dam creek of South Tyger River in Greenville County bounded
 by a line running N.W. by Robt Nelsons land S.W. by William Cabb's line S.E.
 S.W. by Hadworth line N.E. by John Stiles line, now this Indenture witnesseth
 that the s^d William Whaley for an in consideration of the sum of thirty
 pounds Current money of s^d State to him in hand paid by the s^d Eli Turn-
 bough before the signing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold alienated conveyed
 & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell & confirm unto the
 said Eli Turnbough all that tract of land above mentioned together with
 all woods trees waters water Courses profits commodities appurtenances and
 appurtenments & whatsoever unto belonging to the same to hold the s^d
