 A. Meeks being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq. by the oath  
 of Larkin Tarrant was presented & recorded this 18<sup>th</sup> August 1796  
 I know all men by these presents that I William Meeks of the  
 County of Greenville & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina have constituted  
 & appointed & by these presents do constitute make & appoint my  
 loving son A. Meeks of Greenville County in the said State  
 my true and lawful Attorney for me & in my name & to do  
 my use to ask demand sue for, Levy Recover, & receive all such  
 sums of money debts rents, goods, wares, dues, Duties & other de-  
 mands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing payable or  
 belonging to me or detained from in any manner of ways or  
 means whatsoever by any person or persons whomsoever giving  
 and granting to my said Attorney by these presents full &  
 whole power strength & Authority in and about the premises  
 to have use & take all lawful means & ways in my name for  
 the recovery thereof, and upon the receipt of any such debts  
 dues or sums of money aforesaid acquittance or other suffi-  
 cient discharge for me & in my name to make seal & deliver  
 and generally all & every other act & thing & things, devise or  
 devise in law whatsoever needful & necessary to be done in &  
 about the premises for me & in my name to do execute & per-  
 form as fully, largely & amply to all intents & purposes as I my-  
 self might or could do if I was personally or as if the matter  
 required more special Authority than is herein given & Attorney  
 one or more under me fully for the purpose aforesaid to make &  
 constitute & again at pleasure to revoke, ratifying & allowing and  
 holding for firm & effectual all and whatsoever my said Attorney  
 shall lawfully do in & about the premises by virtue hereof In  
 witness whereof have hereunto set my hand & Seal this the 27<sup>th</sup> day  
 of Sept. 1794 & in the Eighteenth year of the Independance of  
 America
