The following deed of gift from In^o Wood to Rob^t, Michael, Mason & Sally Wood being proven before Baylis Carter Esq^r by the oath of Jesse Carter was presented & Recorded this 26th Sept^r 1796

To all to whom these presents shall come greeting Know ye that I John Wood of the State of S^c Carolina County of Greenville for and in consideration of the love & good will & affection which I have and do bear towards my loving children Robert Wood, Michael Wood, Mason Wood, William Wood & Sally Wood have given & granted & by these presents do freely give and grant unto my s^d loving children their heirs and assigns for ever the following property (To wit) one Mare & Cold, three feather beds & furniture, eight pewter plates, eight pewter spoons, one pewter Bason, half dozen knives & forks, one pot, one Dutch Oven, one Shittell, one Kettle, one frying pan, one hundred yards of Cotton Cloth, twelve yards of Thread Cloth, Seventy yards of yarn Cloth, four Geese, fifteen head of hogs, Two Cotton Wheels, one Linnen Wheel, & Two pair of Cards, Together with the Increase of the Stock above mentioned to have and to hold all & singular the property above mentioned unto my said children their heirs and assigns from henceforth as their Just right & property free & clear of all Incumbrance whatsoever and without any manner of Condition In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty fourth day of September 1796

The following deed of Conveyance from Nicholas White to George Hanigim being proven before James Milgore Esq^r by the oath of James Halks was presented & Recorded this 28th September 1796

This Indenture made this 22nd day of March one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Nicholas White of the one part, & George Hanigim planter of the other part both of the State of South Carolina & Greenville County Witnesseth that the s^d Nicholas White for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds lawfull money to him in hand paid by the s^d George Hanigim the receipt is hereby acknowledged by the s^d Nicholas White doth bargain sell and convey unto the s^d George Hanigim a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the State & County afores^d on both sides Durbin's Creek the waters of Enoree in convey^d from Benj^o Roney to the s^d Nicholas White, & from the s^d Nicholas White to the s^d George Hanigim recorded in Lawrence's Registry in Book A page 9029 Bounded S E on William Jones line, & on the N by a line run from the s^d Nicholas White on the W by Thomas Nations line on the S by Free's land from to Center one one hundred & fifty acres with all its appurtenances & things belonging or in any wise appurtenant thereto & also the new
