




 may from time to time & at all times hereafter peaceably & quietly
 have hold occupy & possess all & singular the s^d bargained & sold lands
 and premises with all and every of the appurtenances thereto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining without any manner of hindrance
 or molestation Interruption or denial of him the s^r David Hall or his
 heirs or assigns for ever in witness whereof the afores^d David Hall hath

The following deed of Conveyance of  Matthew Hawkins to William
 White being proven before Reuben  by the oath of Wiley S
 Brown was presented and recorded this  day of January 1799
 State of South Carolina Now all men by these presents that I
 Matthew Hawkins of Greenville County & State afores^d in consideration of
 the sum of sixty pounds to me paid by William White of the County afores^d
 said have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William White a plen-
 tation or tract of land laying & being in the County aforesaid on a small
 creek N^o side of S^o Pristate River begining at a spanish oak & running
 thence N^o 65 E^o 92 ch^o to a red oak, thence N^o 5 W^o 4 ch^o 50 ch^o to a red oak
 thence N^o 48 W^o 9 ch^o to the creek at the mouth of a Branch on the N^o side
 thence up the various meanders of the Branch to a chestnut thence N^o 65 E^o
 23 ch^o 50 ch^o to a blk oak all^o Clines corner, thence with his line S 45 E^o
 15 ch^o to a red oak Edw^o Hawkins Corner, thence with his line S 17 E^o 23 ch^o
 to a blk oak Nejes^o corner, thence with his line S^o W^o being an agreed line
 crossing the Creek to the begining containing by estimation one hundred &
 seven acres be the same more or less being part of two tracts the lower
 end supposed to be sixty acres granted to John Brown by patent
