The following Deed of Conveyance from Isaac Brock to James Brock being
 proven before George Salmon Esq^r by the oath of Elias Earle was presented
 and Recorded this 16th day of January 1797
 This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of December one thou-
 sand seven hundred and ninety three between Isaac Brock of the
 State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & James
 Brock of the said County and State of the other part
 witnesseth that in and by a certain Grant bearing date the ninth
 day of November one thousand seven hundred and eighty six from
 Isaac Brock Esq^r and Mouttrie Esq^r the Governor at the time
 being did give grant unto James Stealy of two hundred and
 sixty eight acres of land situate in the District of Ninety six above the
 Antient boundary line on the branches of the River, and hath such
 forms marks buttings and boundings as appears by a plat to the said
 grant annexed, the said plat and grant being duly Recorded in the
 Secretarys Office witnesseth that the said Isaac Brock for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of fifty pounds Current money to him in full
 truly paid to him in hand paid by James Brock
