334 The following deed of conveyance from Ragland Langston to Elias Earle being proven before John Blasingame Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Langston & James Muckle was presented & recorded this 21<sup>st</sup> January 1797 State of South Carolina } Now all men by these presents Greenville County - - } that I Ragland Langston of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of one hundred and fifty pounds to me in hand paid by Elias Earle of the County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elias Earle, all that part or tract of land whereon I now live containing <sup>hundred & forty</sup> one fifty acres more or less being part of a Tract of six hundred and forty acres granted to Joseph Langston and conveyed to me by said Langston by deed bearing date the sixteenth of November 1795 also one other tract adjoining to it for four hundred fifty seven acres granted to Joseph Langston on the fourth of February 1793 & conveyed to said Ragland Langston on the same date as the above tract including one hundred acres adjoining said land purchased of Hardy Roberts together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all the several Tracts or parcels of land above mentioned unto Elias Earle his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Elias Earle his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August one thousand seven hundred Ninety six and the Twenty first year of the Independance of the United States of America
