

The State of South Carolina Greenville County James Kelgow one of the Justices of the County do hereby Certify unto all whom it may concern that Benjamin Revid wife of the within named Benjamin Revid did this day appear before me, and upon being privately & Separately examined by me did declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce release and for ever relinquish unto the within named Thomas Revid his heirs and assigns all her Inland & State and also all her right & claim of dower if in or to all & singular the premises within mentioned and released given under my hand Seal this 3. day of November 1796

The following Deed from ^{Thomas} ~~William~~ Thomas & Job Bohron to Edward Smith being proven before J. Thomas Junr Esq. by the oath of James Ellington was presented and recorded this 17. day of April 1797
This Instrument made the fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between William Thomas & Job Bohron of the State of South Carolina & County of Townsboro of the one part, & Edward Smith of the said State & County of the other part witnesseth that the said ~~William~~ Thomas & Job Bohron for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds ^{sterling} Money to them in hand paid by the said Edward Smith, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath granted bargained sold, and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien convey and confirm unto the said Edward Smith one hundred & Twenty five acres of land beginning on John Clements line in the midst between Edward Watsons Survey and the old Indian boundary running North to Joseph Smiths line and along S. Clements line to Edw. Watsons thence with S. Watsons line north to his lot, and thence to Joseph Smiths so as to make one hundred & Twenty five acres (the same being part of a tract of five hundred acres of land granted to the said William Thomas & Job Bohron on the seventh day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety four under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. then Governor of the State of South Carolina having the great seal of the State thereunto affixed reference thereto had in a certain Deed of Conveyance in Greenville County on branches of Thompsons Branch of the Tugger River having such form and marks as appear in the Deed of middle Grant annexed, Together with all and singular houses, buildings, orchards meadows, woods, trees, waters, passages, hereditaments, and burdensances whatsoever to the said one hundred and twenty five acres belonging, and the reversion and reversions, remainders and remainders, rents, issues & profits thereof and every part & parcel thereof to have and to hold unto the said one hundred & Twenty five acres with all and every of the premises above mentioned to the said Edward Smith his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever and behoof of him the said Edward Smith he his heirs and assigns for ever and the said William Thomas & Job Bohron their heirs Executors Administrators and assigns against them their heirs assigns & all other persons the bargain, sale, gift, conveyance, or otherwise made or to be made in anywise touching the same
