This Indenture made this twenty third day of April in the year
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
Charles of the State of South Carolina & County
the one part, of John White of said State & County
Witnesseth that said Sarah for and in consideration
one hundred pounds Sterling Money of said State to
truly paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents
whereof she doth hereby acknowledge hath this day before
premises bargain sell and deliver unto said John White
ever all that plantation or tract of land whereon the wt.
Charles now lives containing one hundred acres more
of a tract of three hundred acres Originally Surveyed to
said Sarah by said Wm. Hare as appears from a deed bearing
the second
day of April 1789 begining at a post oak corner of said tract running thence
N.W. 46° 15' E. to a B.C. station & corners, thence S.W. 46° 39'. 40 S. 15' to a post oak
thence S.E. 46° 15' to Old line, thence along said line to the beginning bounded
westwardly by Robert Tamm & W.L. Abbot. Maxwell & on all other sides by
lands now belonging to said White being the tract of land that was exposed
to sale with the rest of my property in order the more conveniently to make
an equal distribution of the same amongst my several heirs & left off by the
under written Joel Charles as will appear from a record of the same in
the Court of Ordinary's Office for the County aforesaid now in the said Joel
Charles for myself my heirs & assigns hereby relinquish all right title and
demand that I might or could in law or equity have to said tract of one hun-
dred acres land under the purchase aforesaid, and hereby further in conjunction
with said Charles hereby warrant and defend the same with all its appear-
ances of the two kind in said White his heirs and assigns to have & to
hold said premises from us or either of us our or either of our heirs to said
John White his heirs or assigns all that tract aforesaid of one hundred acres
more or less together with all the appurtenances in any wise or of any
