

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Reed to John Alexander being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq^r by the oath of A. the Meeks was presented and Recorded this 19th day of April A.D. 1797

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three of the Sovereignty of the United States the eighteenth between John Reed of Greenville County & State of S. Carolina of the one part, & John Alexander of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John Reed doth for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling money of this State to him in hand paid by the said John Alexander at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien, release & confirm, unto the said John Alexander his heirs and assigns for ever all that parcel or tract of land lying and being in Greenville County of the State of S. Carolina on Saluda river bounding westward on Mr. Hobbs land N^o & N^o E^{ast} on lands Originally granted Miles Jennings E. & S. on Joseph Reed & Drury Morey's land S. W. on land Originally granted to John Martin and hath such such former marks the aforesaid to the original grant annexed represents granted to John Reed under the hand of Charles Pinckney the then Governor of the State of S. Carolina bearing date the third day of Dab^r. Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety two containing three hundred and eighty acres together with all and singular the trees waters hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land & premises hereby bargained & sold belonging or in any wise appertaining and reserving & reverning remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said parcel of land & premises hereby bargained & sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said John Alexander his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use & effect absolutely for ever and lastly the said John Reed doth for himself & for his heirs the said tract of land as above described unto the said John Alexander and his heirs against the said Reed and his heirs shall & will warrant & for ever defend in witness whereof the John Reed doth hereunto set his hand seal this day and year above written
